*Magic superior quality sea salt is a salt that produces very pure brine and is strongly recommended for today's water softeners.*

*Magic natural sea salt is gathered in a liquid state in the southern seas. It is carried to large pools where it is exposed to the wind and sun to be crystallized through evaporation. After about five years, the salt crystals can finally be harvested. The crystals are then poured into a brine to remove impurities, washed, and dried in an oven at 185°C (365°F). At this stage, the salt is 99.75% pure.*

## Did you know that...

Too many minerals harden your water? Taking into account the disadvantages of hard water, the additional costs associated with it, and the extra efforts involved in doing household tasks, these facts alone make it worth investing in a water softener. Just think of the additional maintenance required for dishwashers and their significantly reduced life. An Ohio University Study shows that the average time it takes to do household tasks drops by 40% when there is a switch from hard to soft water. (Ref.: The Salt Institute)

## Commonly asked questions:

### DOES MAGIC NATURAL SEA SALT MELT MORE SLOWLY?

It is wrong to believe that the bigger the grain of salt, the longer it will last. Actually, water saturates at 26%\*, making it impossible for the salt to dissolve as long as the brine has not been replaced by unsaturated water. Thus, a 20-kg cube of salt will not supply more brine than a 20-kg bag of small salt crystals. You will not save on volume, no matter what type\*\* of salt you use. However, using Magic sea salt ensures that you obtain high quality brine.

\* Water saturates at 26.395% when it reaches a temperature of 15.56°C.

\*\* There are three types of salt: rock salt (from mines), compacted salt (crystal), and natural sea salt (Magic).

### CAN I USE MAGIC NATURAL SEA SALT IN MY WATER SOFTENER?

Magic sea salt is 100% natural. It contains no additives that can alter the quality of your resin, be it natural or synthetic. You can thus use Magic natural sea salt without any worries, as it is compatible with the water softening equipment available on the market.

### DOES MAGIC SEA SALT PREVENT BRIDGING?

Salt bridges are formed when "crystal" type salt is soaking in the tank to create brine and the water level goes down (such as during a power outage). The salt, which is in contact with air rather than water, hardens permanently and forms a very solid crust or bridge. To prevent this kind of problem, use natural sea salt such as Magic, which stops dissolving when it is no longer in contact with water.

### WILL MY WATER TASTE SALTY?

Salt is used in water softeners to create brine that cleans and regenerates the resin inside. Following an exchange of ions between the resin and the brine, the impurities caught by the resin are directed toward the drain and the resin continues to work effectively. This exchange does not leave your water with a salty taste and does not significantly increase your sodium intake. If you notice that your drinking water tastes salty, contact your equipment specialist, as this is an abnormal situation.

*Magic natural sea salt is an excellent product from Warwick Salt. Because it contains no chemical additives such as binders or color, it represents a positive addition to a healthy diet, be it for you or your family. Magic natural sea salt is also an excellent means of preventing the premature aging of improperly washed resin, thus making your water softener even more effective. In addition, Magic natural sea salt is compatible with all natural or synthetic resin units.*
